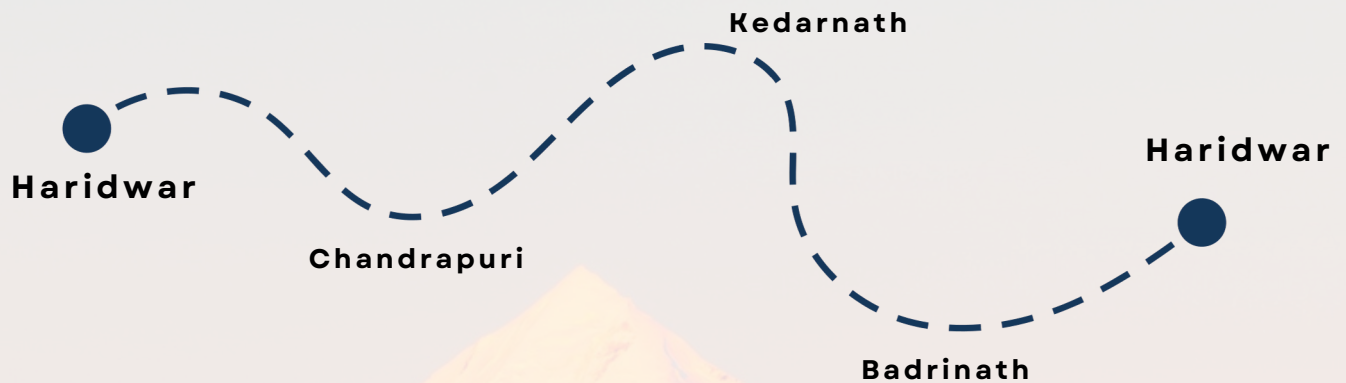

TRAVEL ROUTE DAYWISE



Day 1 - Haridwar to Chandrapuri
(180 km / 4-5 hrs)

- Start early from Haridwar.
- En route, visit Devprayag (Alaknanda & Bhagirathi confluence) and Rudraprayag.
- Reach Chandrapuri (near Guptkashi) by evening.
- Overnight stay in Chandrapuri.

Day 2 - Chandrapuri to Kedarnath
(Drive 45 km)

- Early morning drive to Gaurikund (around 5 AM).
- Start 22 km trek to Kedarnath (or take pony, palki, or ghoda).
- Reach Kedarnath, visit Kedarnath Temple for darshan & aarti.
- Overnight stay in Kedarnath (hotel/camps near temple).

Day 3 - Kedarnath to Chandrapuri
(Drive 45 km)

- Early morning darshan at Kedarnath Temple.
- Trek back to Gaurikund, then drive to Chandrapuri.
- Rest and overnight stay in Chandrapuri.

Day 4 - Chandrapuri to Badrinath
(174 km / 5-6 hrs)

- Depart early for Badrinath via Joshimath.
- En route, visit Rudraprayag, Karnaprayag, Nandaprayag, Vishnuprayag.
- Reach Badrinath, visit Badrinath Temple for darshan & aarti.
- Optional visit to Tapt Kund and Brahma Kapal for rituals.
- Overnight stay in Badrinath.

Day 5 - Badrinath to Haridwar
(300 km / 8-9 hrs)

- Early morning darshan at Badrinath Temple.
- Visit Mana Village (Vyas Gufa, Bhim Pul, Saraswati River Origin).
- Drive back to Haridwar via Joshimath, Rudraprayag, Rishikesh.
- En route, visit Narsingh Temple (Joshimath), Dhari Devi Temple near Srinagar.
- Reach Haridwar by late evening.
